STATISTICS

In DECEMBER 2014 there were 2137 new light commercial vans and buses sold Australia wide. The Toyota Hiace finished first in the pack followed by Mercedes-Benz Sprinter, Hyundai I-Load, Toyota Commuter Bus, VW Caddy, Renault Trafic, VW Transporter, Mercedes-Benz Vito followed by the remaining LCVs.

And in DECEMBER 2014 the highest number of CrewSeat™ rear bench seats were supplied into: the Hyundai ILoad, followed by VW Transporter and Toyota Hiace tied, Mercedes Sprinter, Mercedes Vito, VW Caddy and Toyota TroopCarrier (tied), Renault Trafic with other models bringing up the rear.

REVISION OF VEHICLE STANDARDSBULLETIN 5

Transport for NSW recently revised Vehicle Standards Bulletin 5A and 5B and opened the draft to Public Comment. As the leading aftermarket seat supplier and a key stakeholder in the process, Techsafe Seating engaged in the review process with a number of engineering and certification bodies and submitted a detailed feedback response. We actively support and facilitate the progression of new and safer vehicle standards as part of our absolute commitment occupant safety. The document is still at the draft stage and we will update clients as new developments occur.

Major proposed revisions include:

- a) Combining the requirements of VSB 5A and VSB 5B in the one document
- b) Removal of side-facing seats due to the risk they pose to their occupants
- c) Introduction of shoulder marking labels to indicate the range of occupants who can use the seat based on their shoulder heights
- d) Changes to the categorisation of Category 2 and Category 3 seats to revise the lower age ranges of occupants allowed to use the seats
- e) Introduction of anti submarining features
- f) Removal of child safety harnesses due to difficulties in using them correctly and their likelihood of promoting submarining
- g) Introducing the requirement for Category 2 and 3 seats to have seatbelt anchorages located on the seat structure
